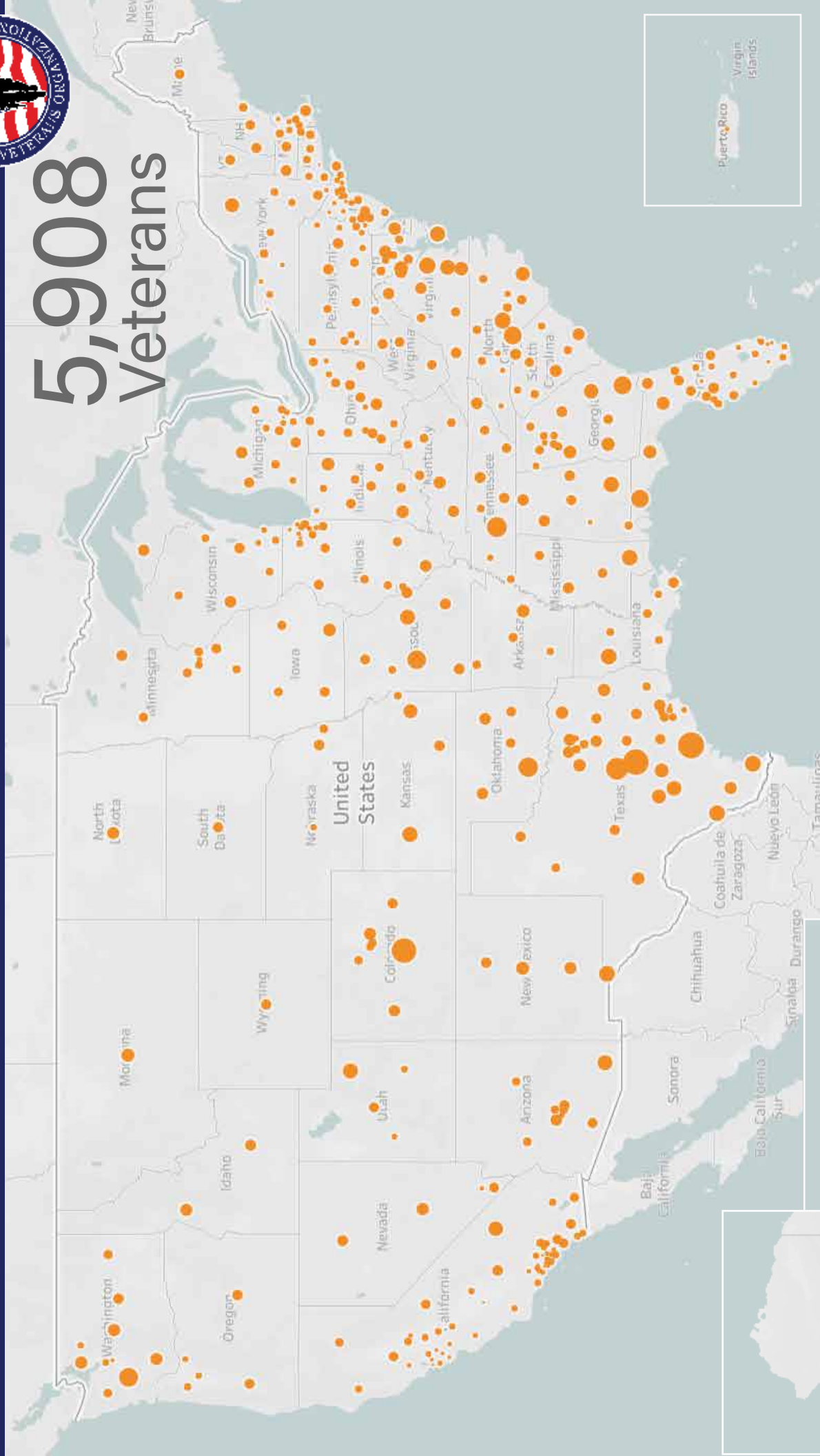


BURN PITS 360 - BURN PIT REGISTRY MAP

Why Register?

In 2013 Congress enacted Public Law 112-260, directing The Department of Veterans Affairs to establish and maintain the Airborne Hazards and Open Burn Pit Registry for service members who may have been exposed to toxic airborne chemicals and fumes generated by open air burn pits.

According to the VA, research does not show evidence of long-term health problems from exposure to burn pits. The VA registry does not permit service members to submit updated health information or for a dependent to submit a death entry by proxy.

Burn Pits 360 established the registry in 2010 to monitor the health of service members and Veterans exposed to open air burn pits. The Burn Pit 360 registry allows eligible Veterans and service members to document their exposures, report health concerns, submit updated health and death entries through an online questionnaire that allows us to track changes in physical and mental health over time, gaps in care and denial of VA benefits.

What will the data be used for?

BURN PITS 360 REGISTRY SELF-REPORTED SYMPTOMS & ILLNESSES

The following symptoms and illnesses listed here are self-reported from the Burn Pits 360 Registry.

SYMPTOMS	
Abdominal pain	Knee pain
Autoimmune	Loss of appetite
Behavior changes (e.g., restlessness)	Loss of muscle control and muscle twitching
Blood in stool	Low back pain
Blurred vision	Low blood pressure (hypotension)
Blurred vision	Low Vitamin D
Body aches	Memory Loss
Chest pain	Minor skin or eye irritation
Confusion and disorientation	Nasal congestion
Congestion	Nausea or vomiting
Constipation	Neck pain
Cough - General	Numbness or tingling in hands
Cough - Passing (comes and goes)	Paleness (pallor) or flushed or yellowish skin
Cough - Persistent	Pelvic pain: Female
Diarrhea	Pelvic pain: Male
Diarrhea - Severe	Rapid heart rate
Difficult or painful urination	Rectal bleeding
Difficulty breathing	Runny nose
Difficulty swallowing	Seizures
Dizziness	Shortness of breath
Drooling	Shoulder pain
Drowsiness	Skin changes
Edema	Skin lesions/rashes
Excessive tearing	Sleep Apnea
Eye discomfort and redness	Sore throat
Eye problems	Soreness or stiffness in the joints
Facial paralysis	Stomach cramps
Fatigue	Stomach Distention
Fever	Sweating
Foot pain or ankle pain	Thirst
